



## Procedures for overseas entrants (short-term visits for academic purposes)

Procedure	Summary
<b>Before entering Korea</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Passport</li><li>- Health declaration form (fill out on the plane)</li><li>- The negative PCR test result (within 48 hours of departure) or rapid antigen test negative confirmation (within 24 hours of departure)</li><li>- Q-code registration (<a href="https://cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/cpassportal/biz/beffatstmnt/main.do?lang=en">https://cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/cpassportal/biz/beffatstmnt/main.do?lang=en</a>)</li></ul> ※ Make sure to check the arrival procedure for each country on the websites of diplomatic missions abroad prior to departure( <a href="https://www.mofa.go.kr/eng/wpge/m_5756/contents.do">https://www.mofa.go.kr/eng/wpge/m_5756/contents.do</a> ).
<b>After entering Korea</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- All visitors are exempted from quarantine upon entering Korea.</li><li>- PCR test within 3 days from arrival (Incheon airport* or nearby clinic**)</li></ul>
<b>Before leaving Korea</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- <b>Follow the policies of the destination country</b> (ex. USA) <b>and airline</b></li></ul> In the case of the USA: The pre-travel testing requirement for passengers boarding on flights departing to the USA from a foreign country <b>has been lifted from June 12</b> . However, most non-US citizens must still be vaccinated to travel to the country.

### 1. Current policy

A. (Currents) From June 8th, all Korean immigrants from overseas are exempted from quarantine regardless of whether or not they are vaccinated. There is no mandatory quarantine, regardless of your history of vaccination, a type of visa etc. (only those with confirmed infection will be quarantined).

B. (Before) Only those who have completed vaccination are exempted from quarantine, 7 days of quarantine for those who have not been vaccinated and those who have not completed vaccination

### 2. Before entering the Korea

A. Time of testing and issuance of PCR(RAT)negative certification

▶ The test must be performed and the PCR negative certificate must be issued within 48 hours (two days) before the departure date.

▶ A supervised negative COVID-19 RAT result must be issued within 24 hours prior to the departure date.

\* (Example) If you are departing from a country to Korea on May 23, 2022 at 10:00, you must submit your negative PCR test result taken after 00:00 on May 21, 2022 or supervised negative RAT result taken after 00:00 on May 22, 2022.

B. Test Results

▶ The test result must be NEGATIVE.

\* If the test result is "INDETERMINATE", "UNCLEAR", or "POSITIVE", the relevant result is invalid.

### C. Language of Test Result

- ▶ The test method must be written in Korean or English.

\* If the test method is written in a language other than Korean or English, a translated copy of the test result in Korean or English needs to be submitted together with a certificate of translation. (If the test result was translated by individual translators, the translated document needs to be certified by a notary office or Korean embassy.)

### D. Q-CODE

- ▶ What is Q-code?

- Q-code is a system established by the KDCA in order to shorten the time for quarantine inspection and provide the conveniences overseas entrants require upon entry to the Republic of Korea.

- Anyone who inputs normal quarantine information through Q-code will be able to avail fast and convenient quarantine inspection after their arrival at the Republic of Korea.

- for those who do not use the Q-code, it may take a lot of time for document inspection upon entry, so please enter the information in the Q-code system before boarding the plane and complete the issuance of the QR code for a quick quarantine investigation.

- ▶ Preparation to input Q-code

- ① (Mandatory) Valid passport

- ② (Mandatory) Valid E-mail address

- ③ (Mandatory) Valid airline ticket

- ④ (Mandatory) Valid 'Confirmation of COVID-19 PCR Negative Test Result'

- ⑤ (Mandatory) Health Condition Information

- ⑥ (Selective) Valid 'Certificate of COVID-19 Vaccination'

- ⑦ (Selective) Valid 'Quarantine Exemption'

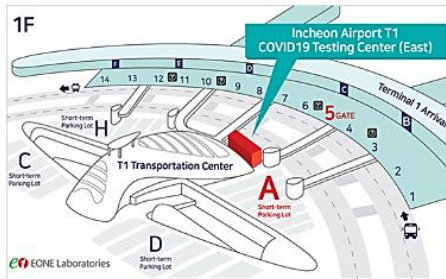

### 3. After entering Korea

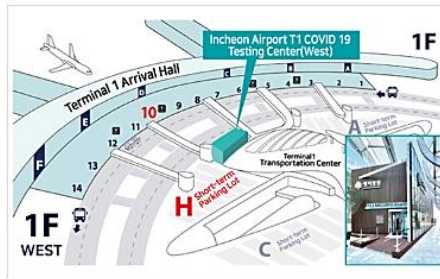
A. Asymptomatic: PCR test within 3 days from arrival (Incheon airport\* or nearby clinic\*\*) / About 80,000 KRW

#### 1. Incheon International Airport

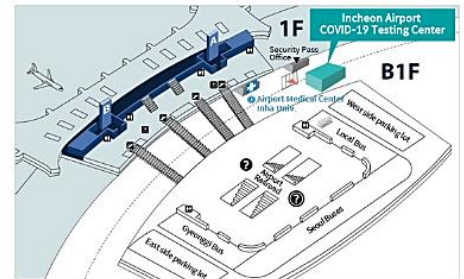
- ▶ Incheon Airport COVID-19 Testing Center provides COVID-19 test and issues certificate for inbound and outbound passengers. Incheon Airport manages 2 COVID-19 Testing Centers(East / West) at T1 and 1 COVID 19 Testing Center(West) at T2. You must bring your passport to take COVID-19 test and get certificate.

#### B. Symptomatic

- ▶ PCR test Arrival gate or Incheon Airport National Quarantine Station)
  - Positive → Transfer to hotel, hospital or Residential Treatment Center
  - Negative → Entering
- ▶ The availability of support for COVID-19 quarantine costs varies by country. You must contact the embassy or call KDCA(1339).



### 3. Before leaving Korea

- ▶ Please visit the website of the relevant embassy or contact your airline's customer service center for details and guidance on entry restrictions and requirements, such as certificates, vaccination, and self-quarantine.
- ▶ Please be aware that countries may suddenly change their entry restrictions without prior notice, so make sure to stay updated before your departure.
